Visual Fixation and Function in Central Vision Loss

- People with visual impairment due to conditions like macular degeneration lose their central vision, which makes it difficult for them to read, drive a vehicle or recognize faces.
- <u>Aim</u>: To understand the eye movement pattern and residual visual function in people with central vision loss.
- <u>Why Participate?</u> To help vision scientists better understand the central visual impairment, that is pivotal for devising rehabilitation strategies in the future.
- <u>Who can Participate?</u> If you have some form of 'Macular degeneration' in <u>both</u> eyes and a distance vision that is better than 20/400 in your better seeing eye.
- <u>What to Expect and How Long?</u> Recording of eye movements, imaging and assessing the functioning of your eyes. A single study visit, <u>approximately 2 hrs.</u> long, including rest breaks.
